

Samford Courts Shed – Must be locked at all times when not in use.

The Auburn Pickleball Club (APC) has sole access to the locked storage area (the shed) at Samford Courts. It is very important that the balls and other APC equipment is locked when no one from the APC is there. Our dues pay for the items in the shed. The city is not the responsible party, we are.

We keep a combination lock on the overhead door to prevent loss, theft, or damage to our property. When you leave the courts, verify whether you are the last player or not.

If you are not the last player there, talk to the other APC members staying and ask them to gather all the club balls and equipment you are leaving on the courts, put them in the shed and lock the shed.

If you are the last player there, gather all the balls and equipment, put them in the shed, and lock the shed.

To securely lock the shed, the slider must be closed, the combination lock must be inserted into the left set of holes (the lock is easier to open when in the left holes), and the combination lock securely closed. To close the combination lock so it is locked, set the lock to the correct combination while the clasp is open, close the clasp tightly (you should hear/feel a small click), while the clasp is closed tightly, turn the number dials to other numbers. Ensure the lock is locked by pulling on it. If it opens, try again until it is securely locked. Thank you!
